

Sponsor a Little Tern Tracker

The North Wales Little Tern Group are offering a sponsorship programme to fund tracking devices which will reveal the migration route and wintering locations of these threatened seabirds over the 2019-2020 seasons.

Little Tern is amber listed in the UK and has seen the UK population fall to 1700 pairs in recent years. Despite the improving knowledge for conserving the species on the breeding grounds, little is known about threats on the migration or wintering grounds. These devices will help uncover the route they take and where the favoured areas are to spend the winter. This is a first for Western Europe on this species so you will be part of a ground-breaking project!

The trackers are tiny and weigh less than a gram. They will be attached to the leg of the bird during the 2019 season and then it will be possible to re-sight them on nests using cameras when the birds return in 2020 and retrieve the tracker to analyse the data. Some have already been funded but more would add to what is learnt from the project.

For £100 you will be able to fund a whole tracking device. In return you can:

- Name the bird
- Receive a photo of the bird with tag
- Newsletter about the project after the 2019 season

- Have the tracker once retrieved

For £50 you will be able to fund half a tracking device. You can also:
